The Department of Pediatric Hematology and Oncology, CancerCare Manitoba (CCMB), the Oncology Program, Winnipeg Regional Health Authority (WRHA), and, the Department of Pediatrics & Child Health, College of Medicine, University of Manitoba (U of M), are seeking applications for a Pediatric Hematology/Oncology position. This will be a full-time faculty position at the rank of Assistant Professor (dependent on qualifications).

Candidates must be eligible for registration with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Manitoba. Certification in Pediatrics and Pediatric Hematology Oncology; or eligibility for certification from the Royal College is preferred. The successful candidate will be expected to provide high quality in-patient and out-patient care to patients with malignant and hematologic disorders as part of a multidisciplinary team at the Children's Hospital, Health Science Centre and CancerCare Manitoba. There will be opportunities for collaboration with basic and clinical researchers at the Children's Hospital Research Institute of Manitoba and the Research Institute in Oncology and Hematology, a joint institute of CancerCare Manitoba and the University of Manitoba. Specific interest and experience in clinical trials administration and operation will be an asset.

The Program presently consists of seven faculty members with active clinical and research programs in pediatric oncology, bone marrow transplant, hematology, hemostasis and thrombosis. It is the sole Pediatric Hematology/Oncology Program, seeing patients from across the Province.

CancerCare Manitoba, the Winnipeg Regional Health Authority, and the University of Manitoba are strongly committed to equity and diversity within its community and especially welcomes applications from women, members of racialized communities, Indigenous persons, persons with disabilities, persons of all sexual orientations and genders, and others who may contribute to the further diversification of ideas. All qualified candidates are encouraged to apply; however, Canadian citizens and permanent residents will be given priority. Only candidates selected for an interview will be contacted.
