Regimen Reference Order – GAST – gemcitabine

ARIA: GAST - [gemcitabine]

Planned Course: Adjuvant: Days 1, 8 and 15 every 28 days for 6 cycles

OR

Metastatic: Cycle 1 - weekly for 7 of 8 weeks OR weekly for 3 of 4 weeks

Cycle 2 onwards - days 1, 8 and 15 every 28 days until disease

progression or unacceptable toxicity

Indication for Use: Pancreatic Cancer

CVAD: At Provider's Discretion

Proceed with treatment if:

ANC equal to or greater than 1.5 x $10^9/L$ AND Platelets equal to or greater than $100 \times 10^9/L$

Contact Physician if parameters not met

Flush after each medication:

• 50 mL over 6 minutes (500 mL/hr)

Drug	Dose	CCMB Administration Guideline	
metoclopramide	10 – 20 mg	Orally every 4 – 6 hours as needed for nausea and vomiting

- Reinforce applicable safe handling precautions of medications, blood and body fluids for 48 hours after completion of chemotherapy
