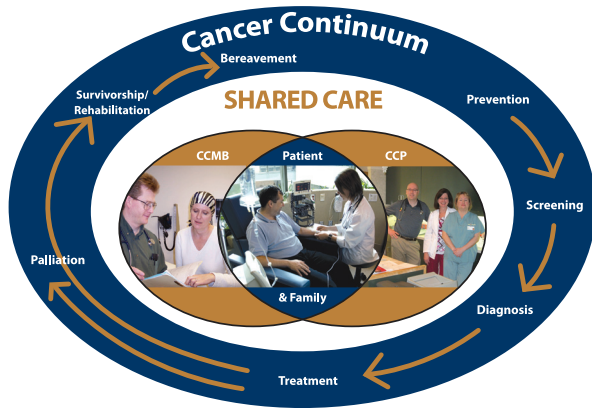

# The Community Cancer Programs Network

## What is the Community Cancer Programs Network (CCPN)?

The Community Cancer Programs Network (CCPN) is a provincial program of CancerCare Manitoba that works in partnership with the Regional Health Authorities. It enables patients living outside of Winnipeg to receive quality cancer care closer to home.



## Is a Regional or Community Cancer Program for you?

Many cancers can be treated safely in a regional or community site. Your primary care provider or surgeon will refer you to a cancer specialist (oncologist) in Winnipeg. Your cancer specialist plans your treatment and together with you, decides on the best location for your care. You may be eligible for treatment at a CCPN site. Just ask your oncologist if this is right for you.

## Where are the Regional & Community Cancer Programs (RCPs & CCPs) located?

The CCPN is comprised of 7 Regional Cancer Programs (RCPs) and 8 Community Cancer Programs (CCPs), the Western Manitoba Cancer Centre (WMCC), and the Community Cancer Resource & Support Program (CCRSP) in Eriksdale.

RCPs, CCPs and the Brandon WMCC are outpatient units that provide chemotherapy treatments and follow-up care, and are located within the regional or community hospitals. In addition to chemotherapy treatments, the WMCC also provides radiation therapy services as well as radiation oncology expertise.



## Who will care for you at the Regional & Community Cancer Programs?

You will be cared for by a team of doctors, nurses, pharmacists, social workers and other support staff who have received specialized training in oncology. Nurse Navigators are also strong members of the team and they are available in all regions. Cancer Navigation Services are free of charge to all residents living in Manitoba.

Your cancer specialist maintains ongoing communication with the local team and retains overall responsibility of your care.

## What if you have other needs?

In addition to Cancer Navigation, other support services such as cancer support groups, palliative care, nutritional counseling and volunteer drivers may be available as well.
